Dear Parents,

This letter comes to you with a sincere concern about our parking lot; for both drop off and pick-up.

Drop Off: Please drop off your child at the northeast part of the parking lot in front of the west door.

Pick-Up: All students/parents are asked to use the crosswalk on the north side of the school and parking lot, then proceed directly to a circling vehicle or a parked car

*It is very dangerous for students to enter or exit a vehicle by the north side of the church and dodge traffic to get to a car or the school. One student was hit in the parking lot last year.

Parent and student cooperation is very important to keep all of our students SAFE.
