#### → Art Literacy Program

Volunteers needed for 1 or 2 times per month in all classrooms. This program supplements the Utah state core curriculum taught in art class by Mrs. Oswald. Art history and the study of Utah and other famous world artists are included in the curriculum. Materials and lesson plans are provided.

#### → Book Fair

Help Linda Paoletti organize our wonderful book fair, which is held in conjunction with the King's English bookstore. This library fundraiser occurs during October.

#### → Hospitality

This committee organizes all non-fundraising social events. Events include: Mentor Family Social (Sept.); Grandparents' Brunch (Oct.); two dinners for teachers during parent-teacher conferences (Nov & Feb.); and open houses for potential new families (Jan./Feb.).

#### → Mardi Gras

Mardi Gras is our largest fundraising event and is generally held on the Saturday before Ash Wednesday. There are many subcommittees that take charge of different aspects of this event, so there is something to suit everybody's schedule and interests.

#### → Mardi Gras Class Projects

This committee works with the Mardi Gras committee and the room representatives to help each class think of and create a unique piece of artwork, furniture, quilt, picture, book, etc. to auction off at Mardi Gras. If you're a creative person, you'd be wonderful on this committee.

#### → Mentor Family Program

During the summer, this committee pairs new families with existing Cosgriff families, communicates with the families, and assists the Hospitality Committee with hosting a social, which is held in August.

#### → Spaghetti Dinner

This fun school/parish event takes place on a Saturday evening at the end of January. Most of the planning for this dinner takes place in January.

→ **St. Patrick's Day Parade**

This committee is in charge of the Cosgriff/St. Ambrose float. They secure necessary vehicles and organize a float-decorating party, which is held the night before the parade.

→ **Tiger Teams – Class Fundraising Committees**

Four “Tiger Teams” have been formed to develop and host one or two fundraising events per team per year. Teams are organized as follows: Pre-school, Kindergarten – 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade, 3<sup>rd</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> Grades, and Middle School (6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grades). → **Teacher Appreciation**
